**Helen FARLEY is an Associate Professor (Digital Futures) at the Australian Digital Futures Institute at the University of Southern Queensland, Australia. She is currently leading the University of Southern Queensland-led Collaborative Research Network (CRN) project with the Australian National University and the University of South Australia to develop a Mobile Learning Evaluation Framework. She is also the project lead of the Australian Government Office for Learning and Teaching-funded 'From Access to Success' project which will develop an internet-independent version of Moodle that will enable electronic access to course materials and activities for those students without internet access. This**

**project has been so successful that Helen and the Australian Digital Futures Institute were awarded \$4.4 million through the Australian Government's Higher Education Participation and Pathways Program to take the Moodle and notebook computers to Indigenous and non-Indigenous incarcerated students across Australia. Helen has many years' experience as an educator in Higher Education and as a researcher of educational technology. Her research interests are focused around the use of mobile technologies, virtual worlds and using technology to promote participation in Higher Education.**
