Dr. ASKAR received her high school education at TED Ankara Private High School. She graduated from Middle East Technical University with a BS degree in Mathematics Education (major) and Physics Education (minor) in 1979. Her Ph.D was on educational measurement and evaluation (major), curriculum and instruction (minor). She worked as a Dean of Faculty of Education at TED University between 2011-2014, as a full professor of sociometry at İzmir University of Economics for a year, computer education and instructional technology at Hacettepe University for eleven years and mathematics education at Middle East Technical University for five years. She served as a board member of the Student Selection and Placement Center in Turkey between 2004-2010.

Dr. Askar, has been involved in several projects on ICT applications in education at both the school and national level. She worked as a research coordinator at IBM Computer Aided Education Center, in Turkey and was the head of Information Technologies in the Education Division of the Ministry of National Education. She is currently a member of the editorial boards of several journals and editor in chief of Elementary Education Online. She has developed or adapted more than twenty tests and instruments in Turkish.

Her current interests are implementation and analysis of e-learning environments, development of computer based neuropsychological testing and ontological representation of cognitive skills.

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
