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RELATIONS OF ANADOLU UNIVERSITY OPEN EDUCATION SYSTEM FEMALE STUDENTS WITH INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGIES

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ABSTRACT

Anadolu University Open Education System, established in 1982 in Turkish education system, gave education to almost 3 million graduates and currently has been giving higher education to approximately 1.500.000 students.
