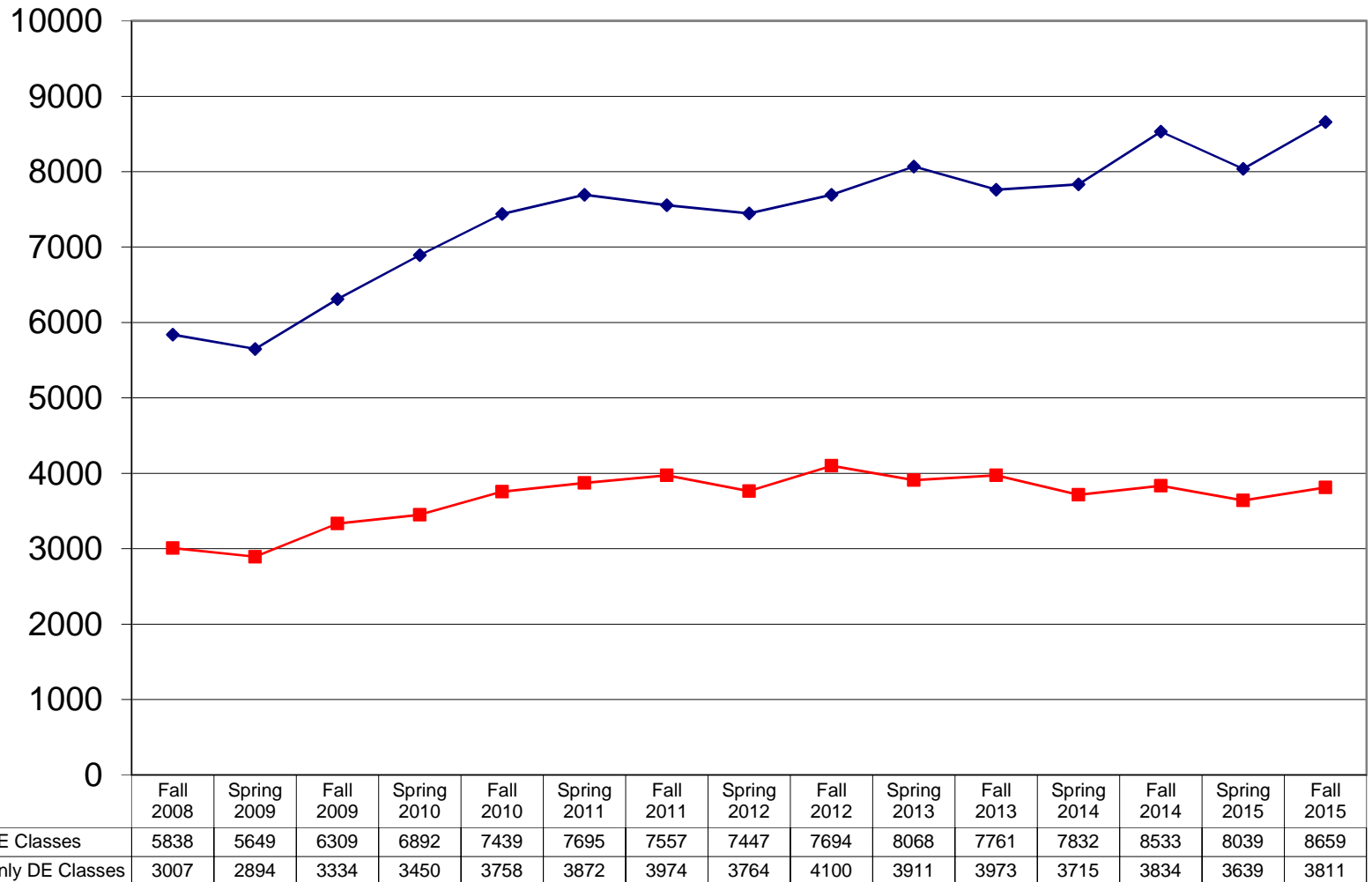

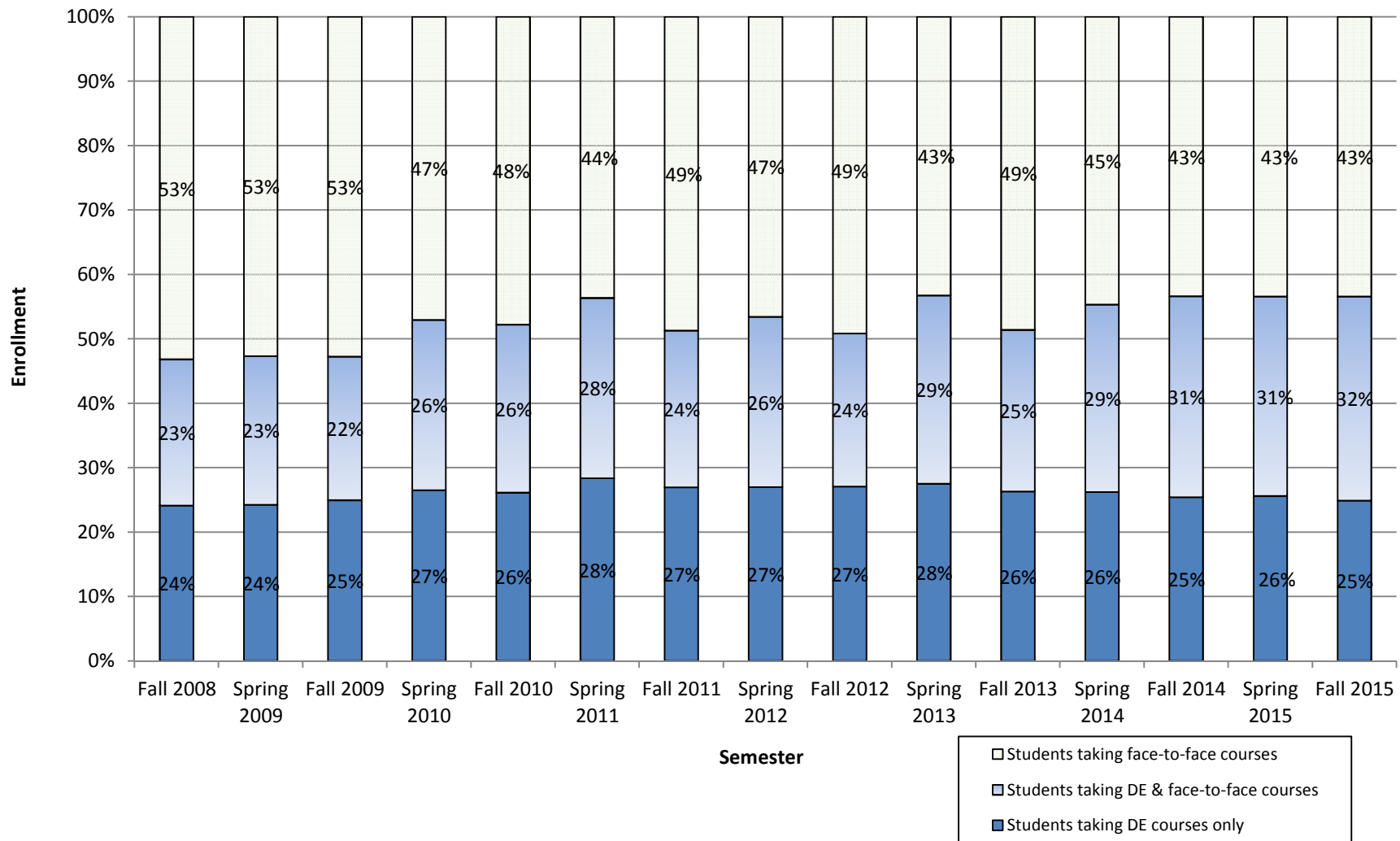

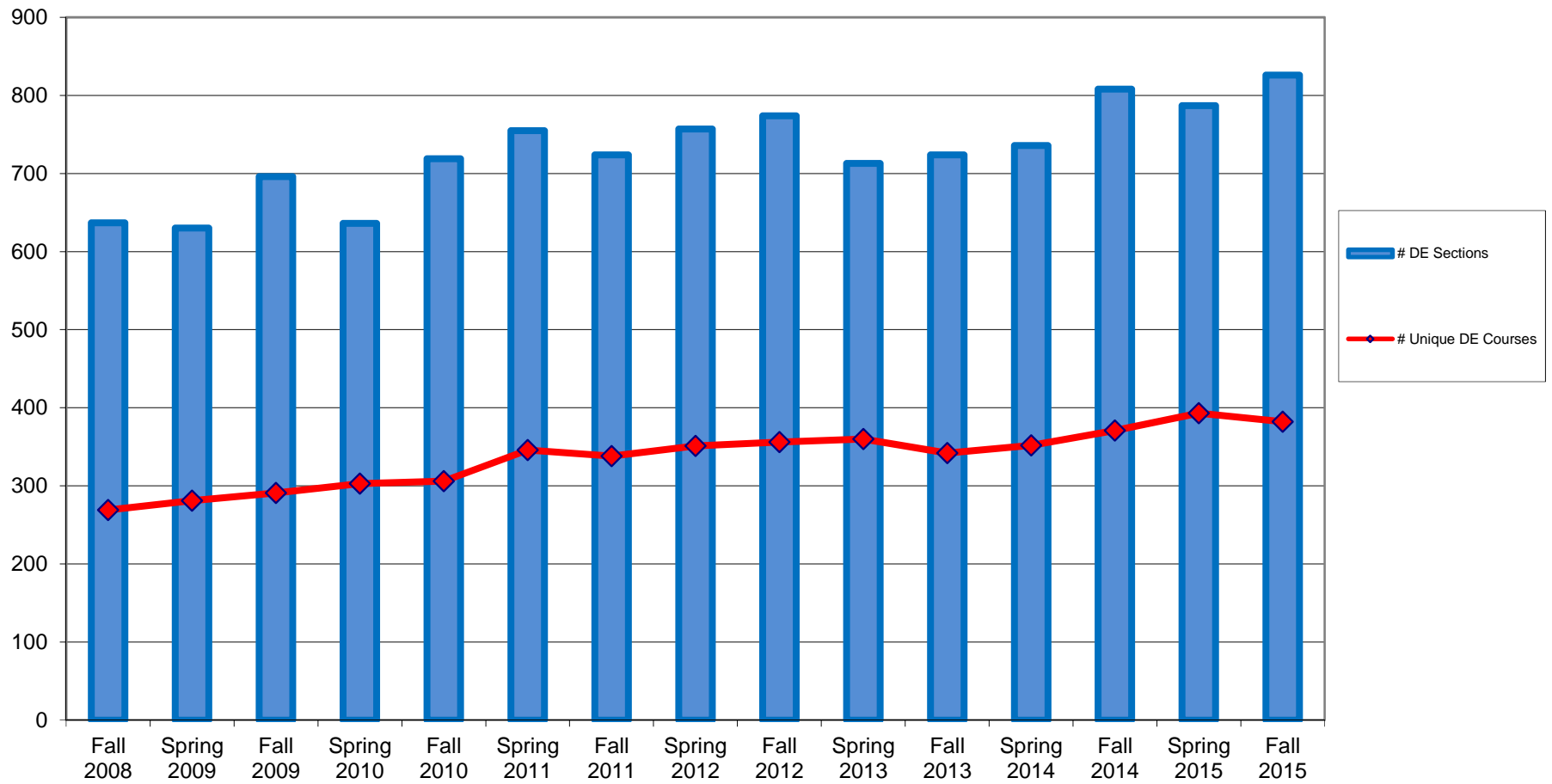
# Students Taking Distance Education Classes Only



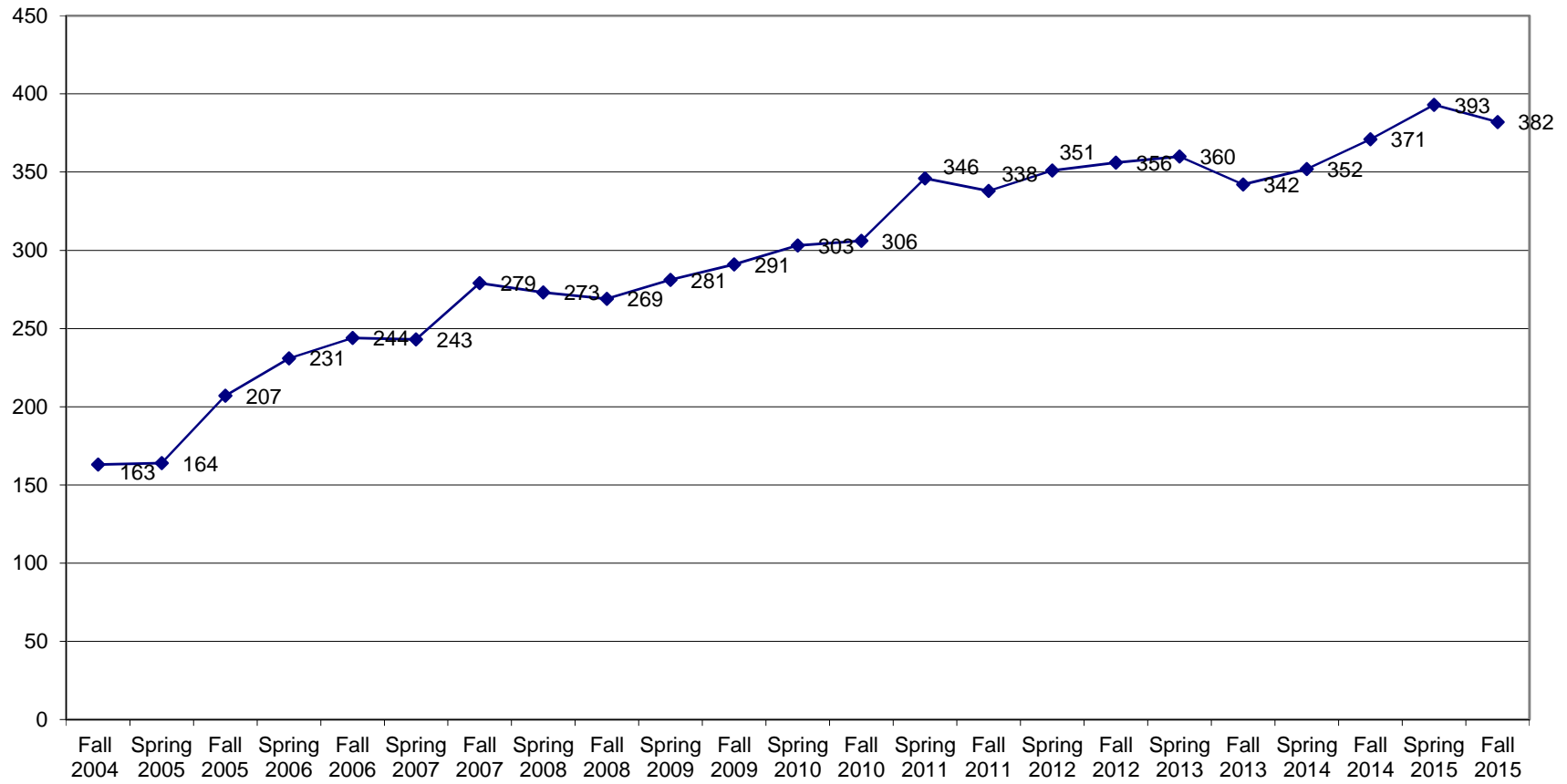
## Distance Education as Percent of Total Enrollment



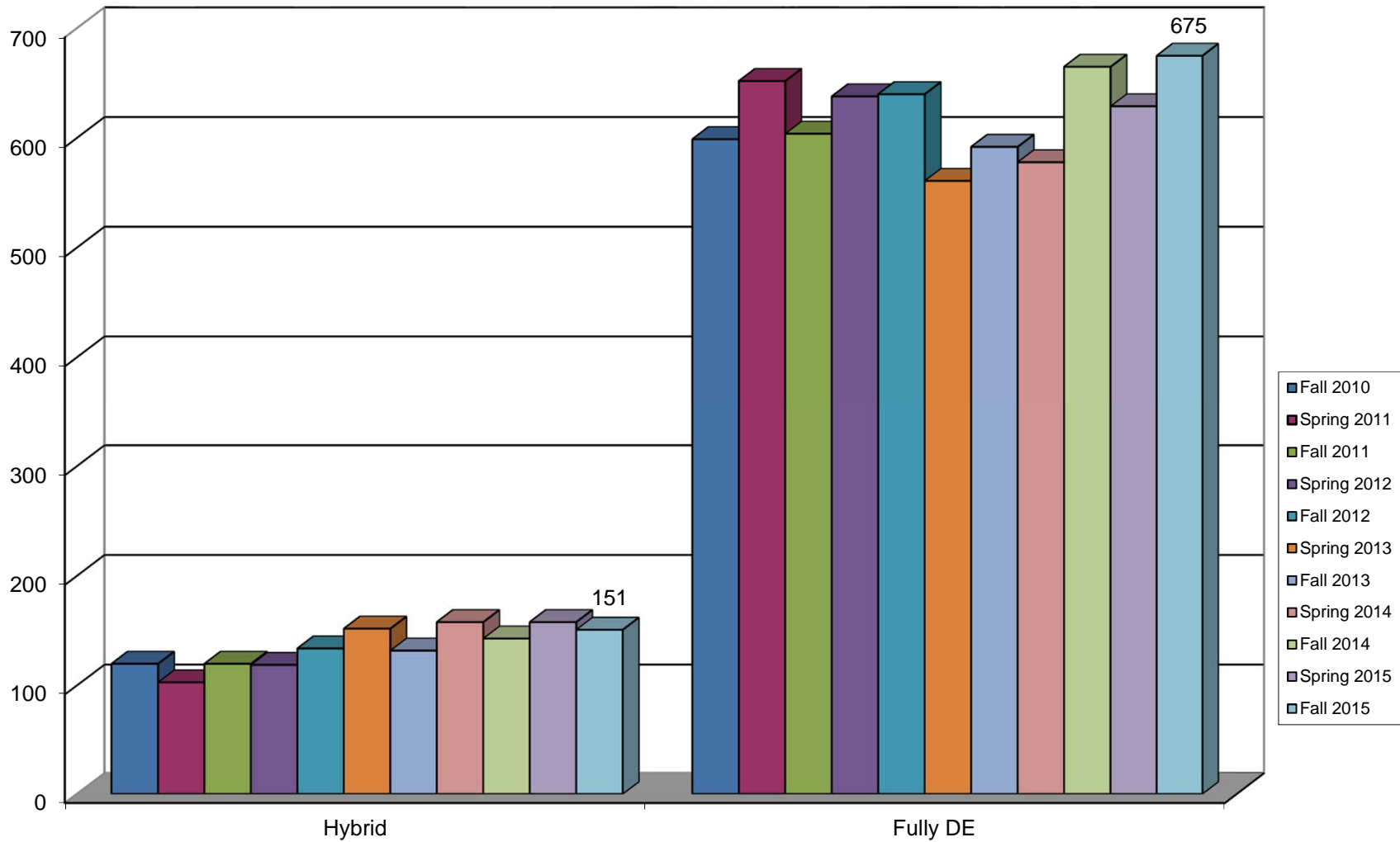

# Number of Unique Distance Education Courses at TWU

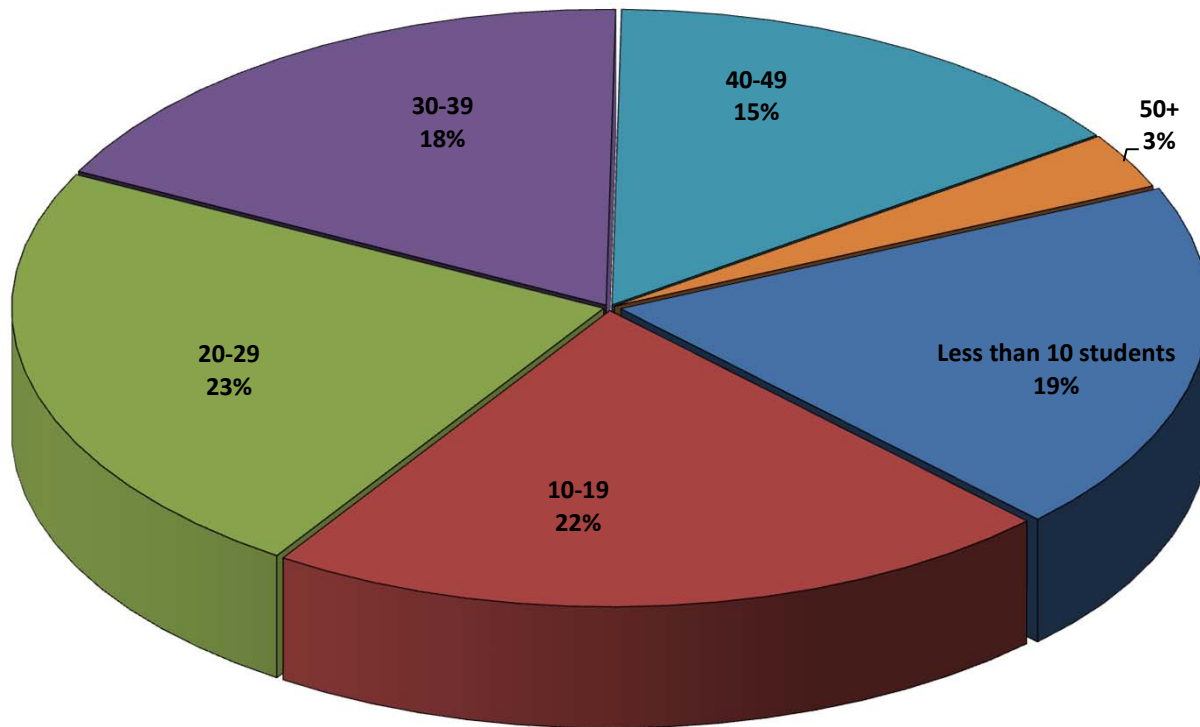


## Distance Education Sections by THECB Classifications

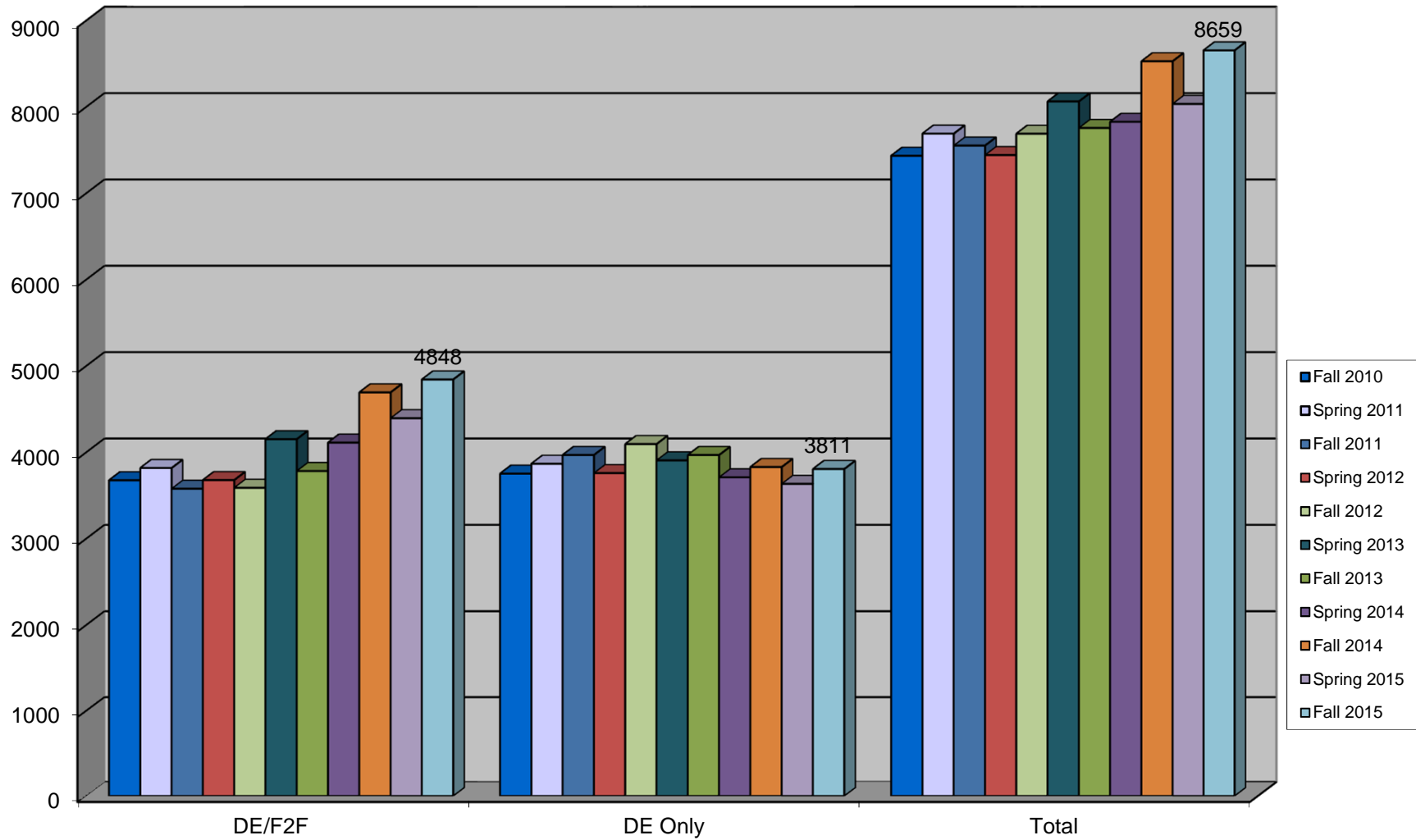




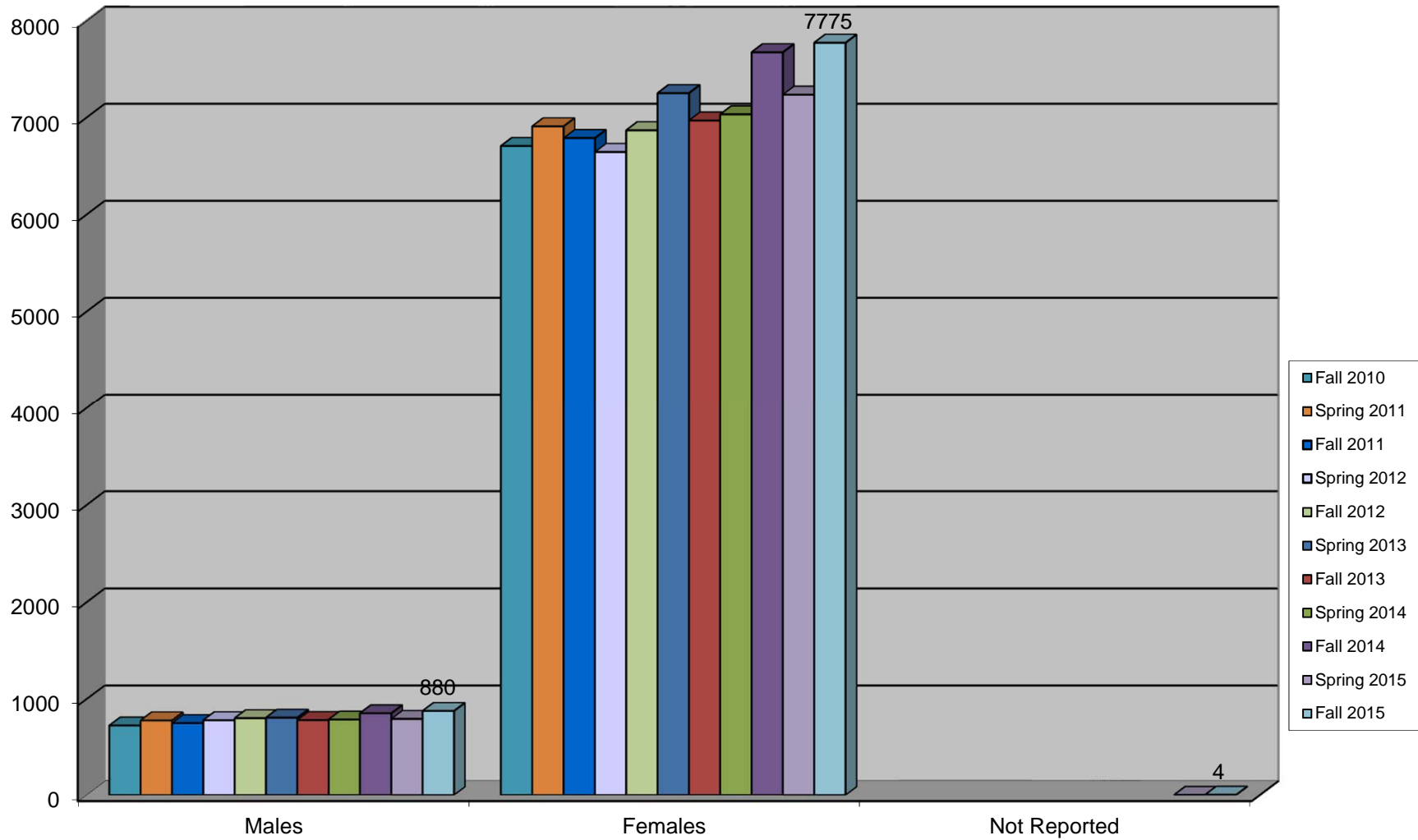
## Distance Education Section Size Fall 2015



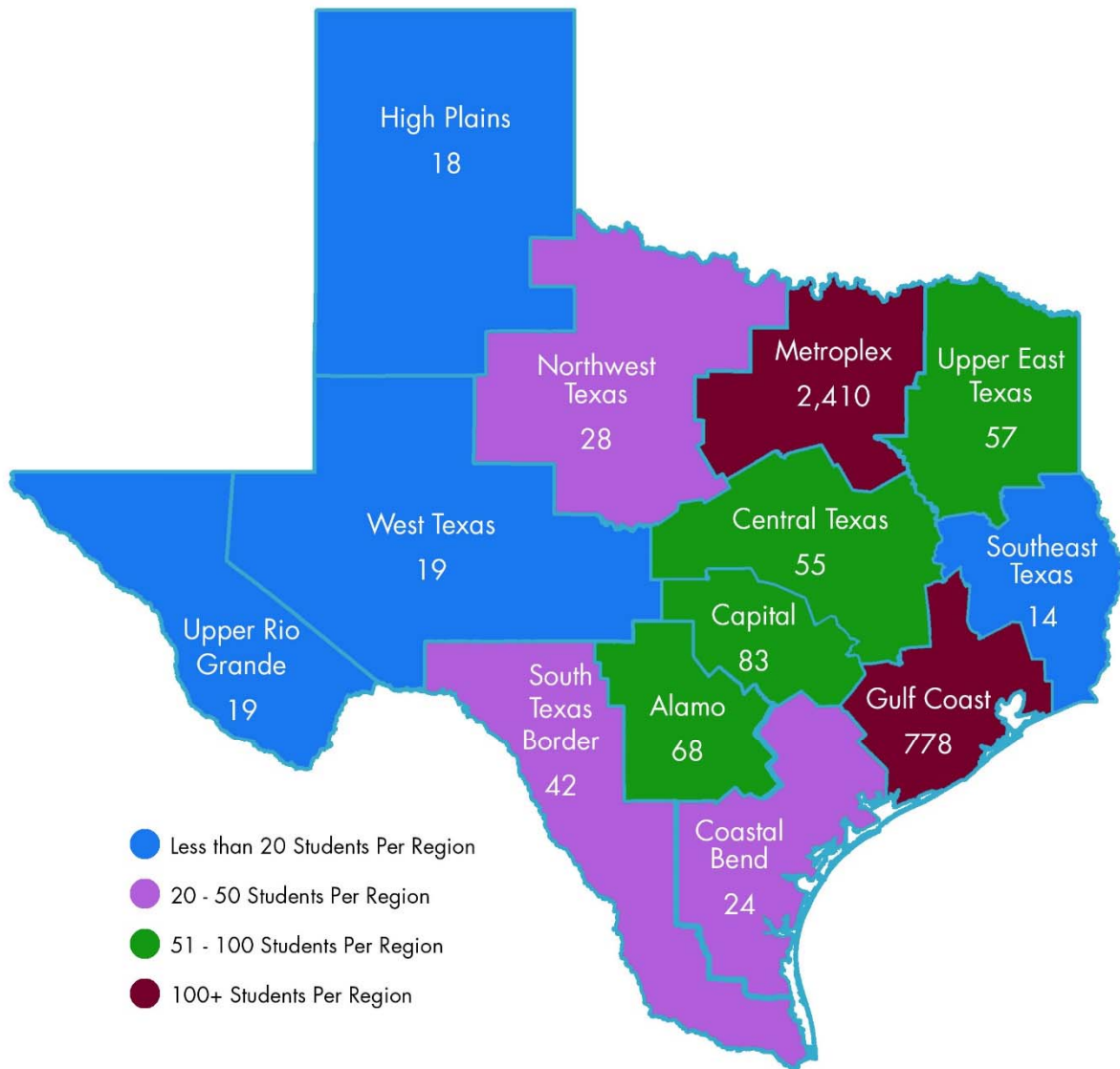
# Distance Education Enrollment by Instructional Method



# Distance Education Enrollment by Gender



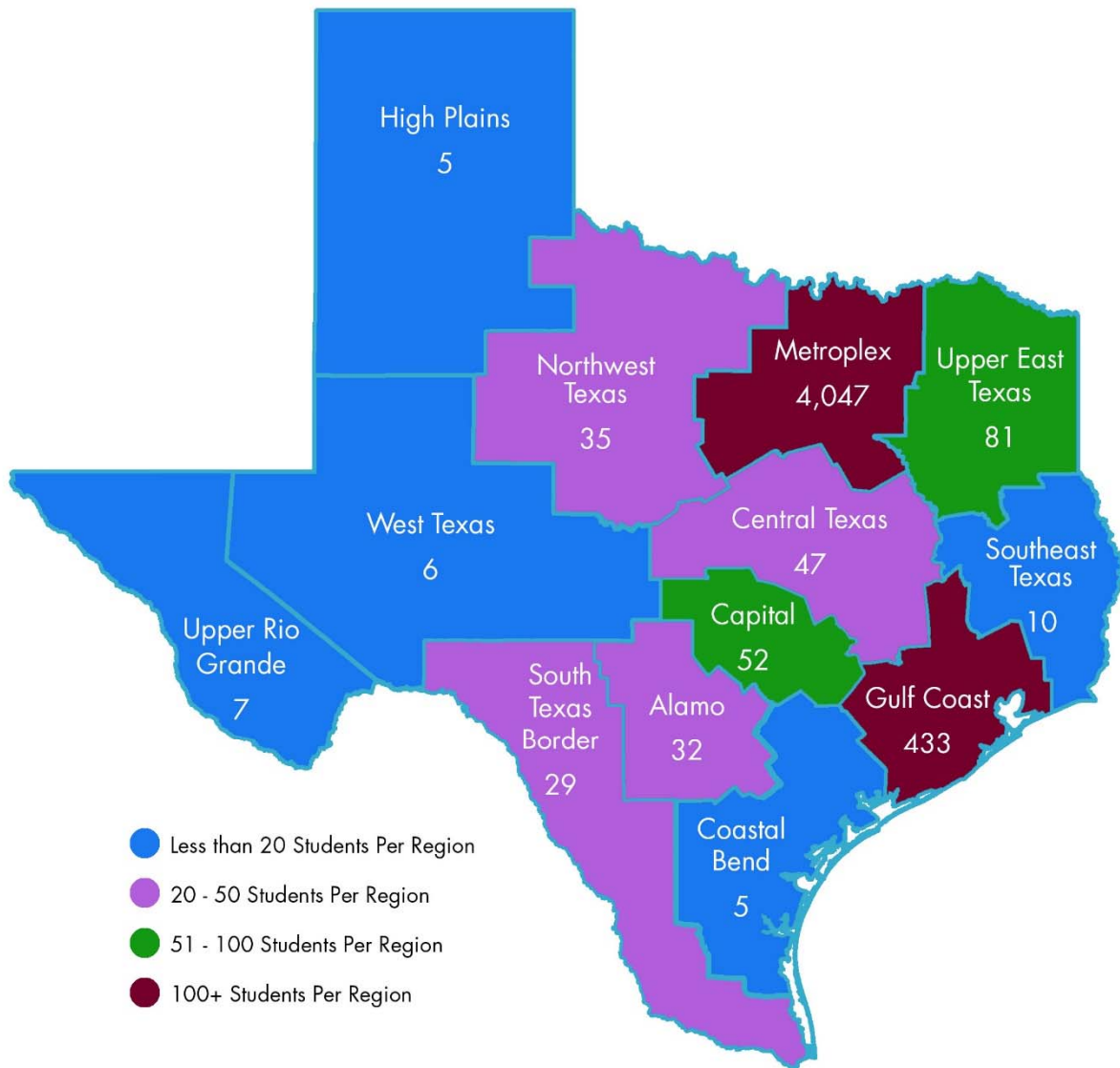
# Student Enrollment by Region Distance Education Only Students

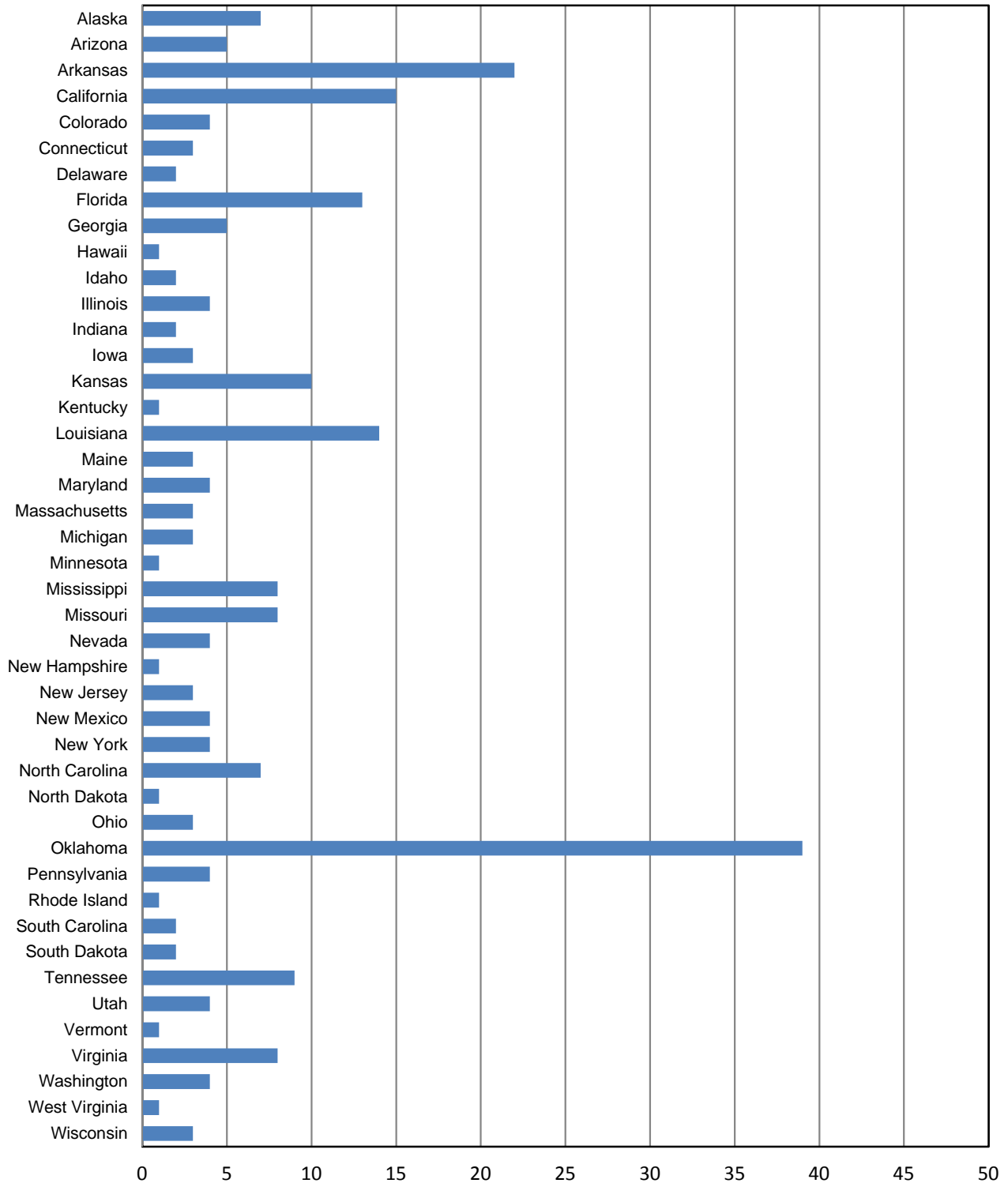

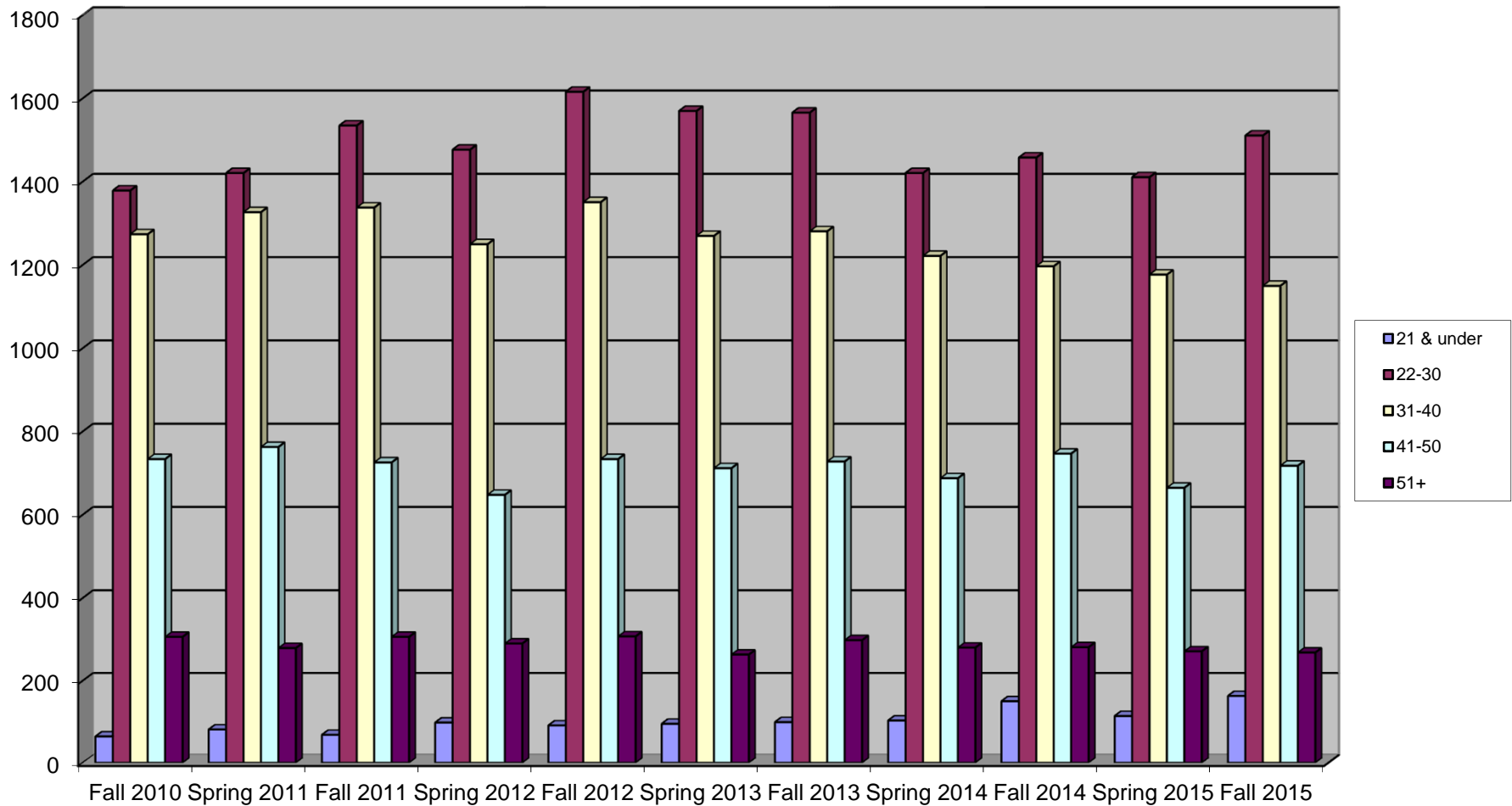

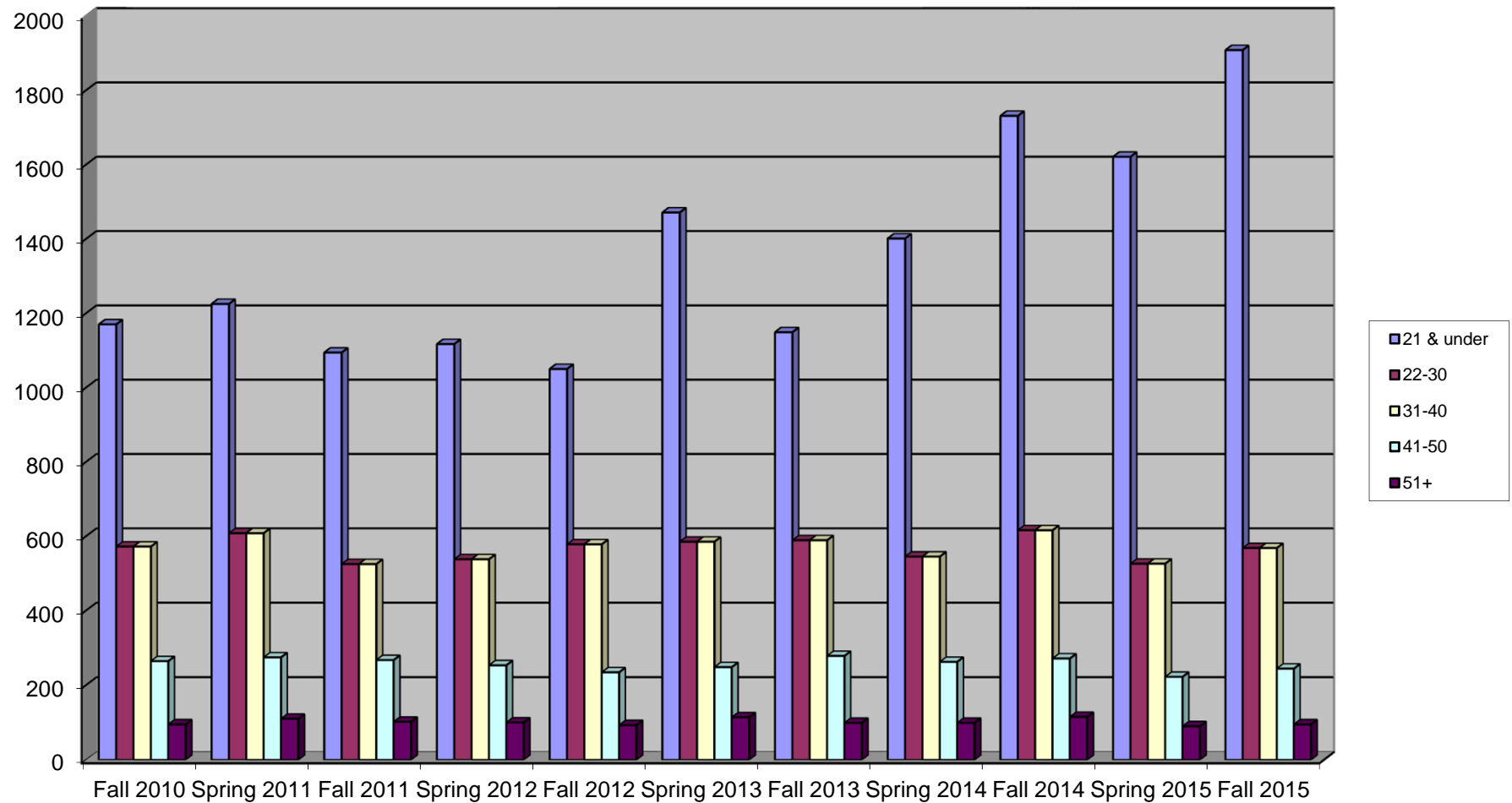
# Location of Out-of-State Students Taking DE Courses N=248



# Student Enrollment by Age Range Distance Education Only Students

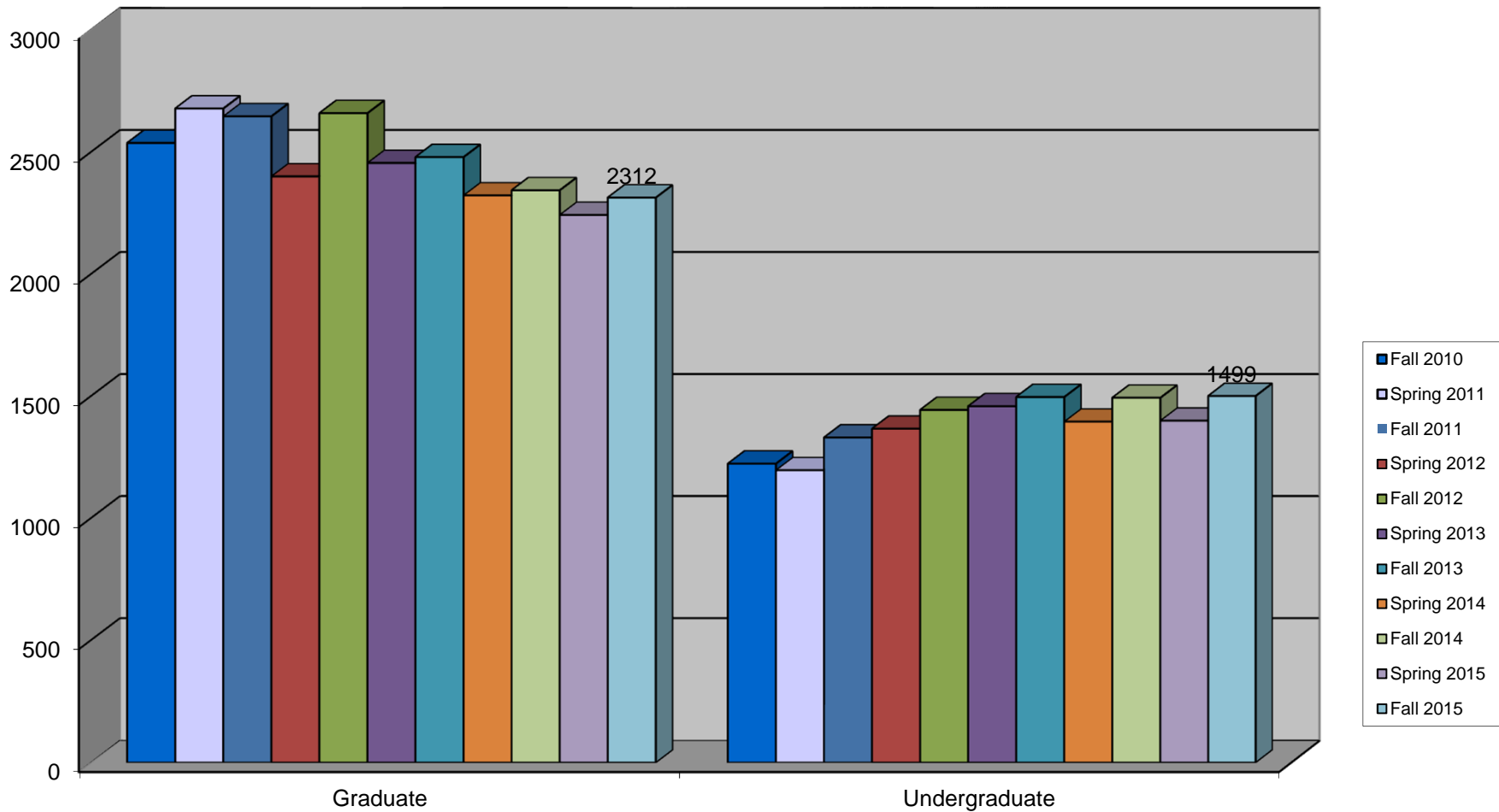


## Student Enrollment by Age Range Distance Education/Face-to-Face Students

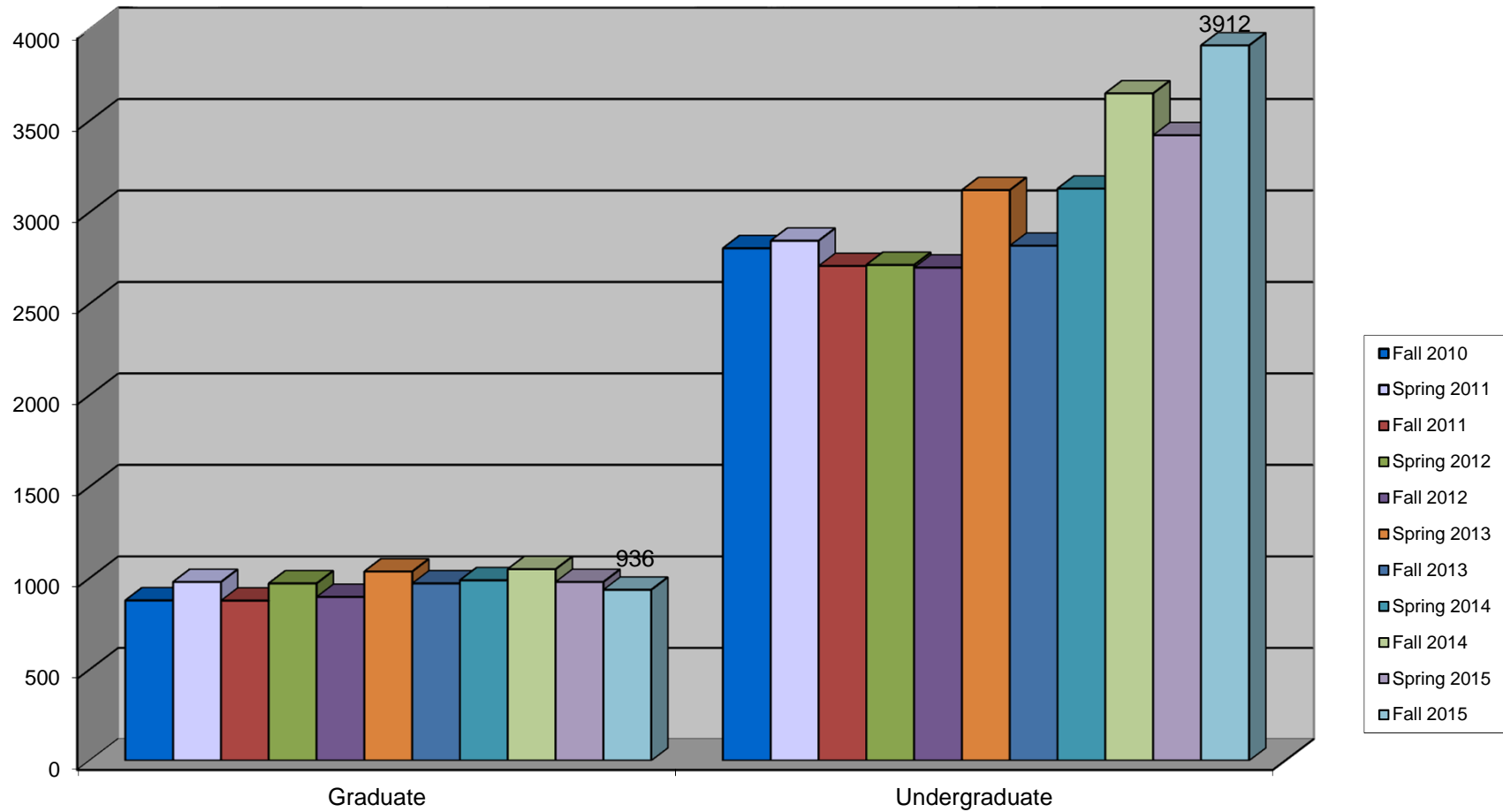




# Student Enrollment by Academic Level Distance Education Only Students

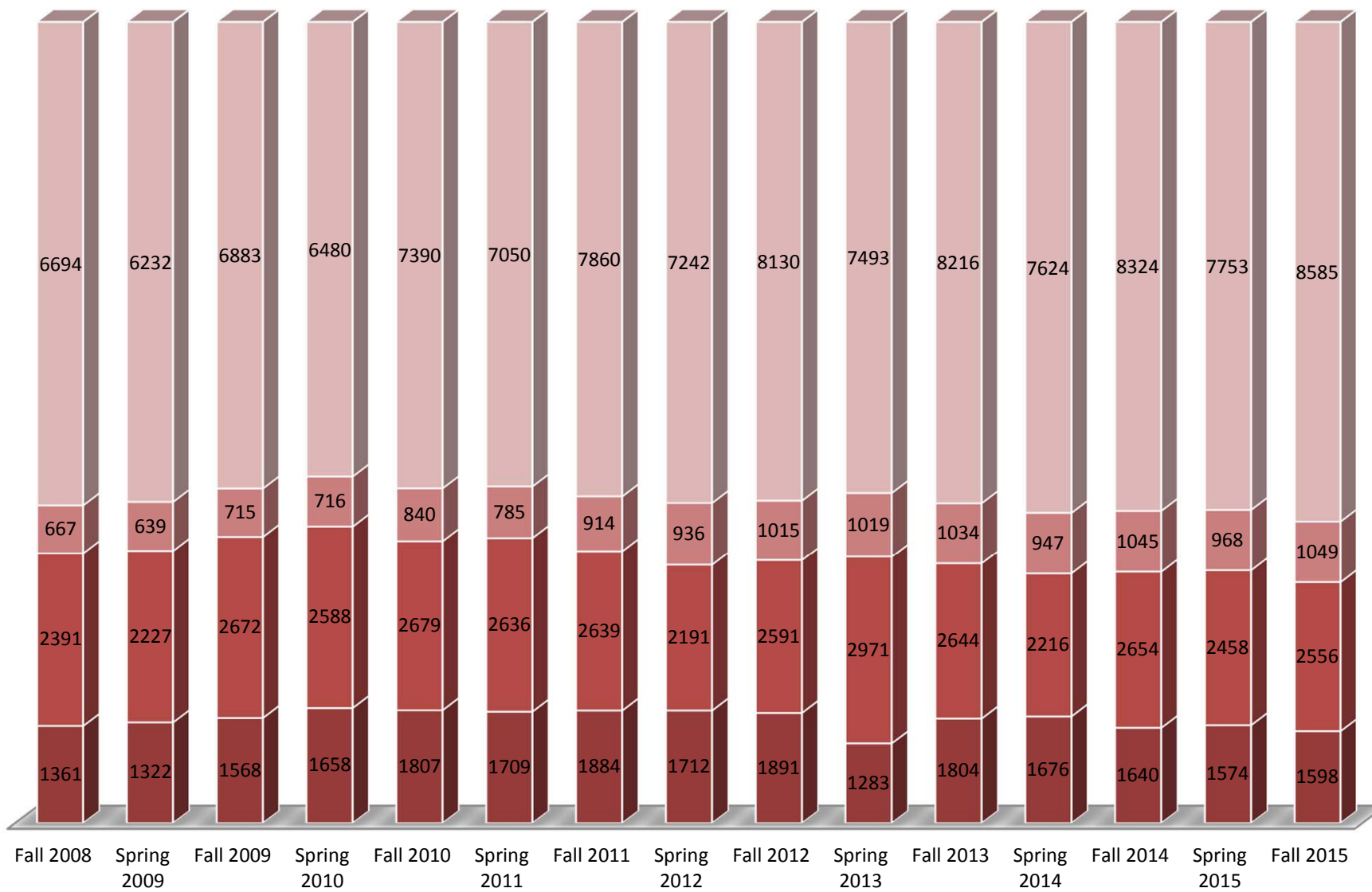

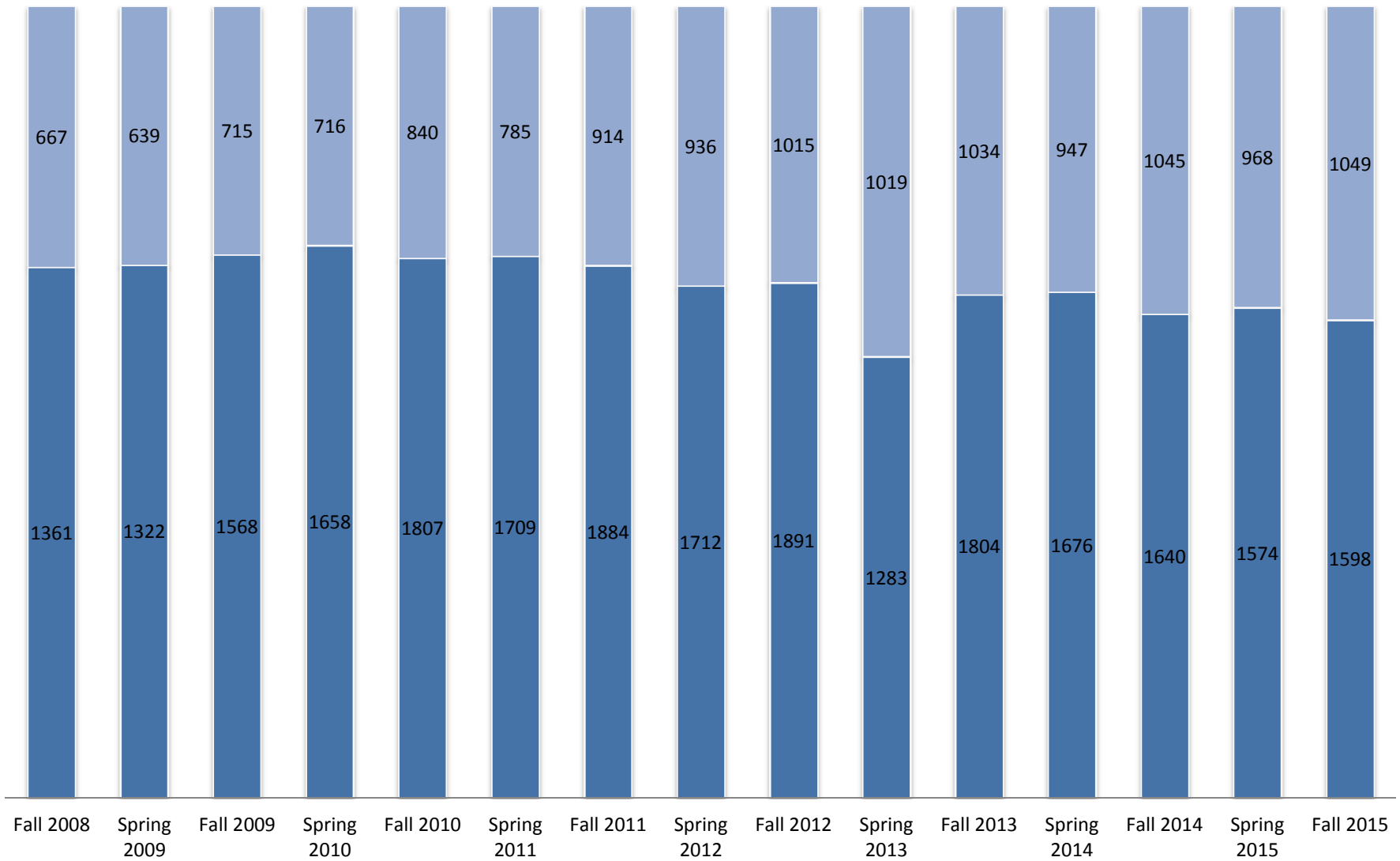

*Students Taking Only DE Courses*

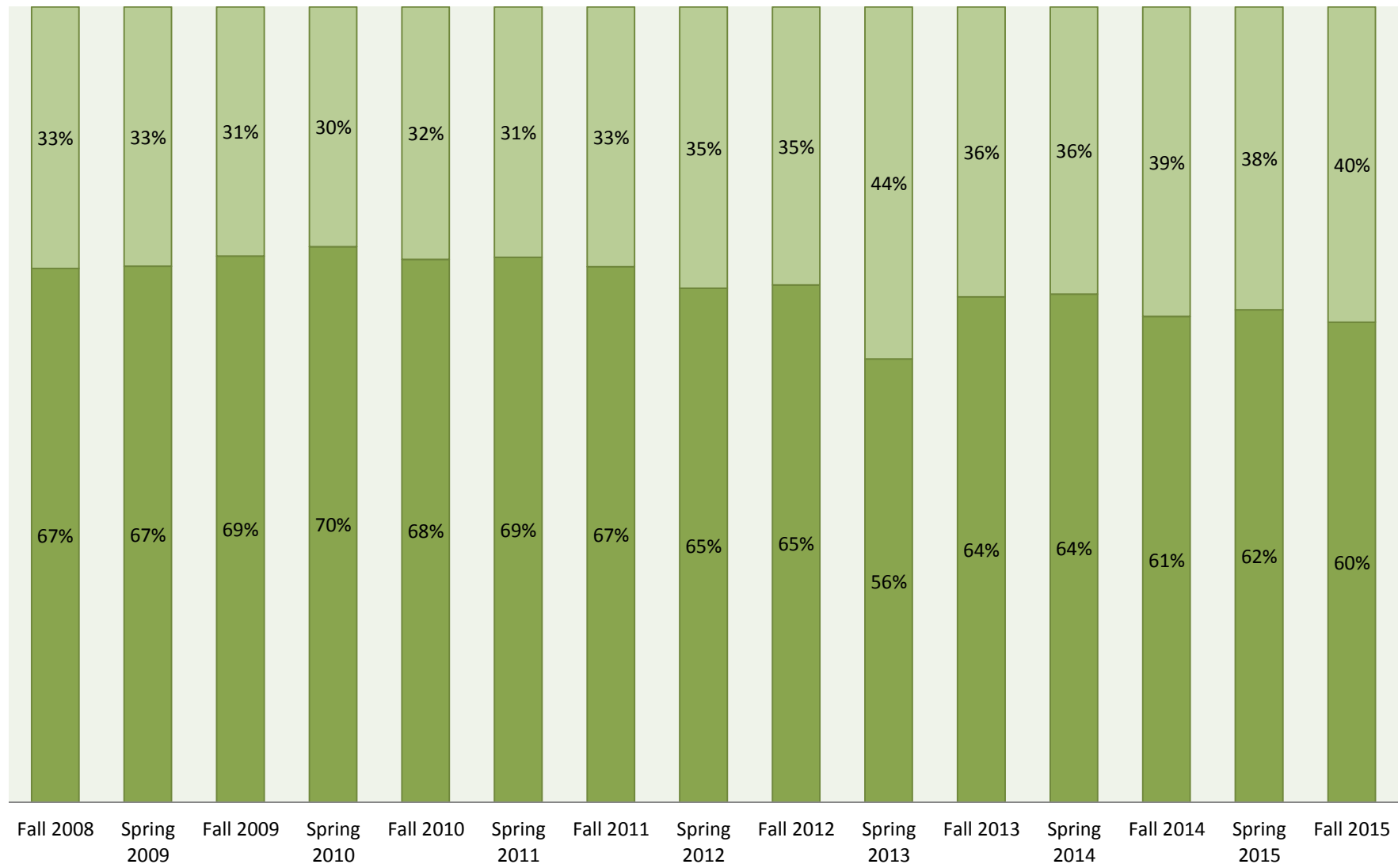

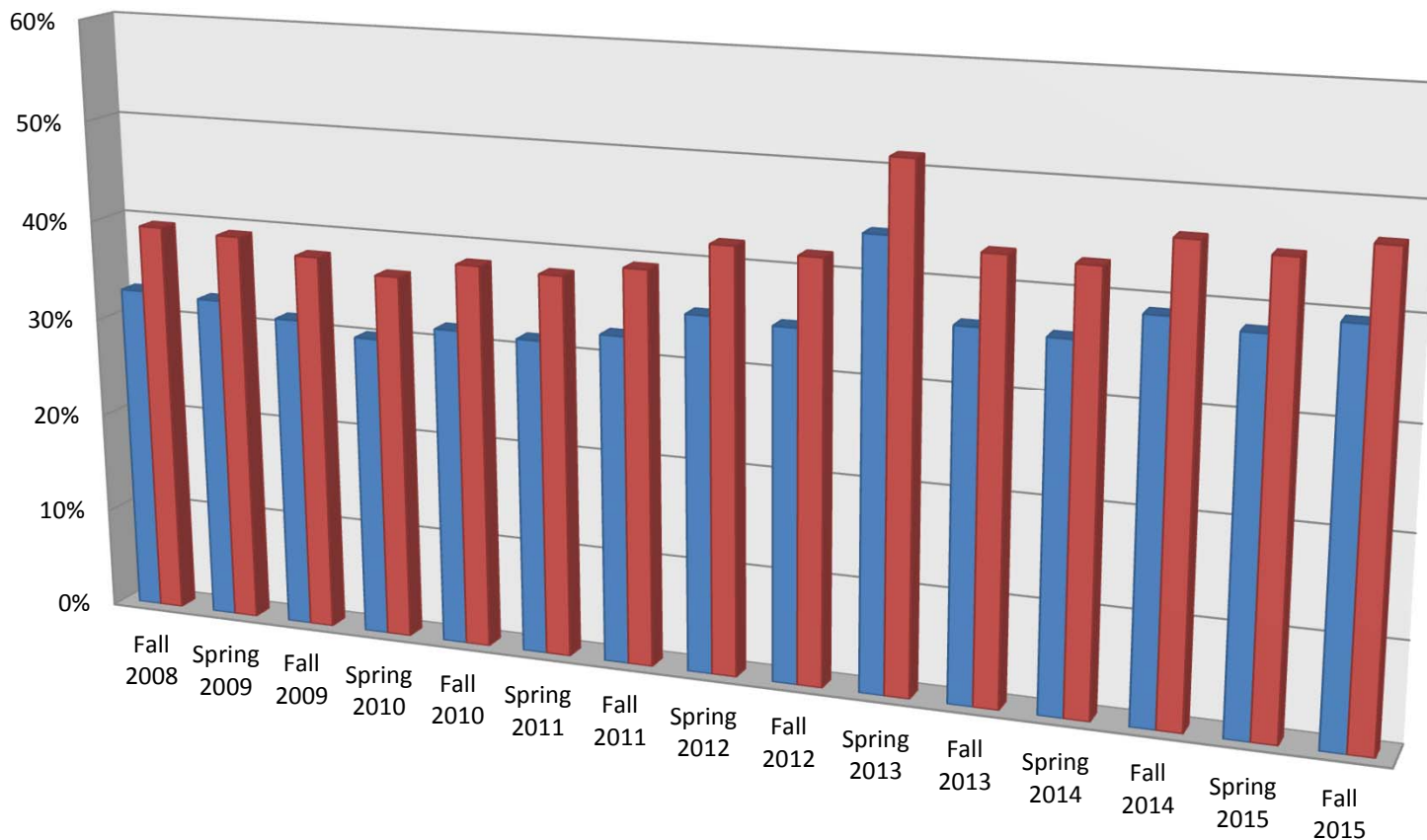
## TWU Distance Education % FTE Grad/Undergrad Ratio by Year

■ DE Grad FTE %   ■ DE Undergrad FTE %

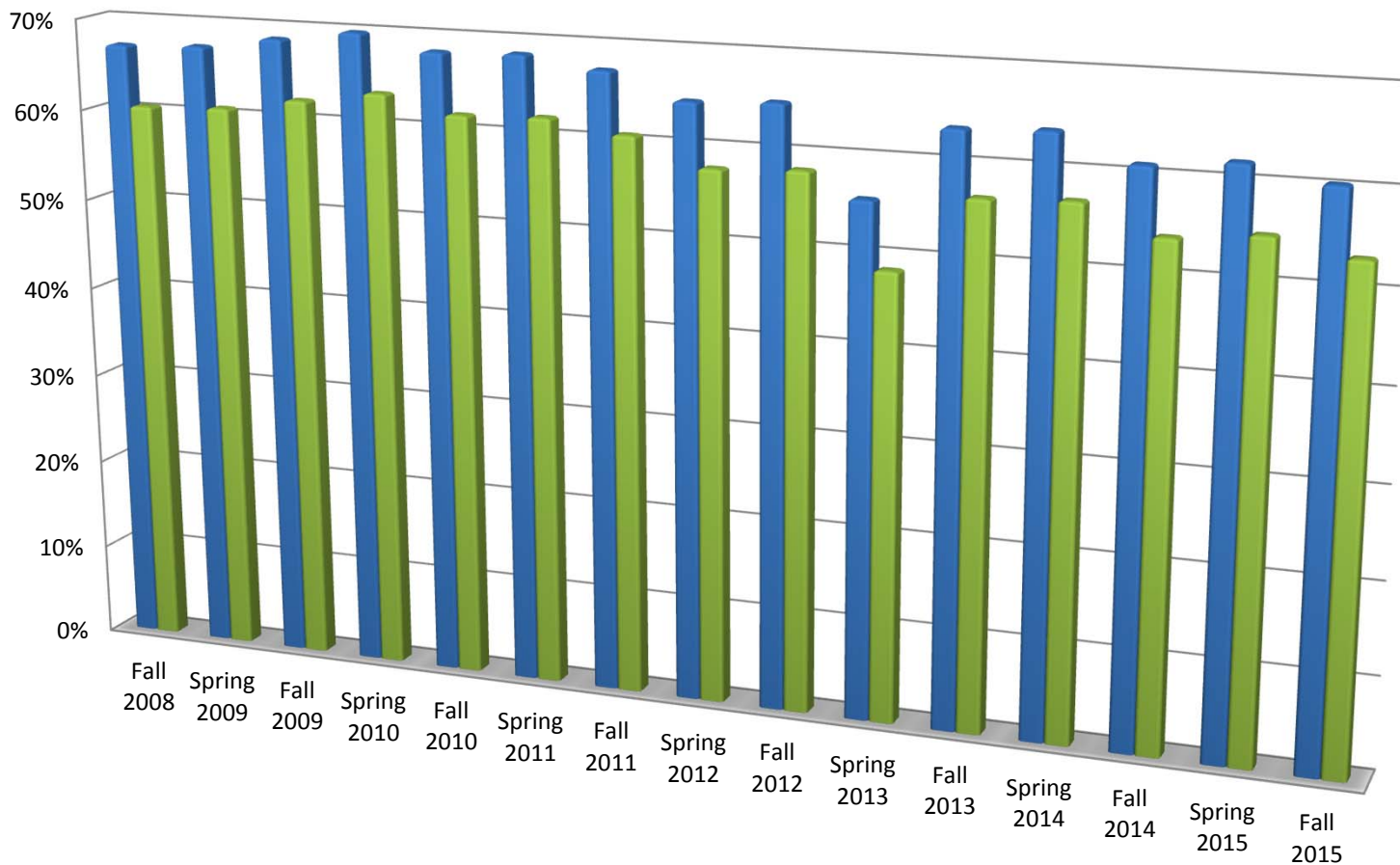


## Percentage of Distance Education FTE & SCH Generated by Undergraduate Students by Semester *Students Taking Only DE Courses*



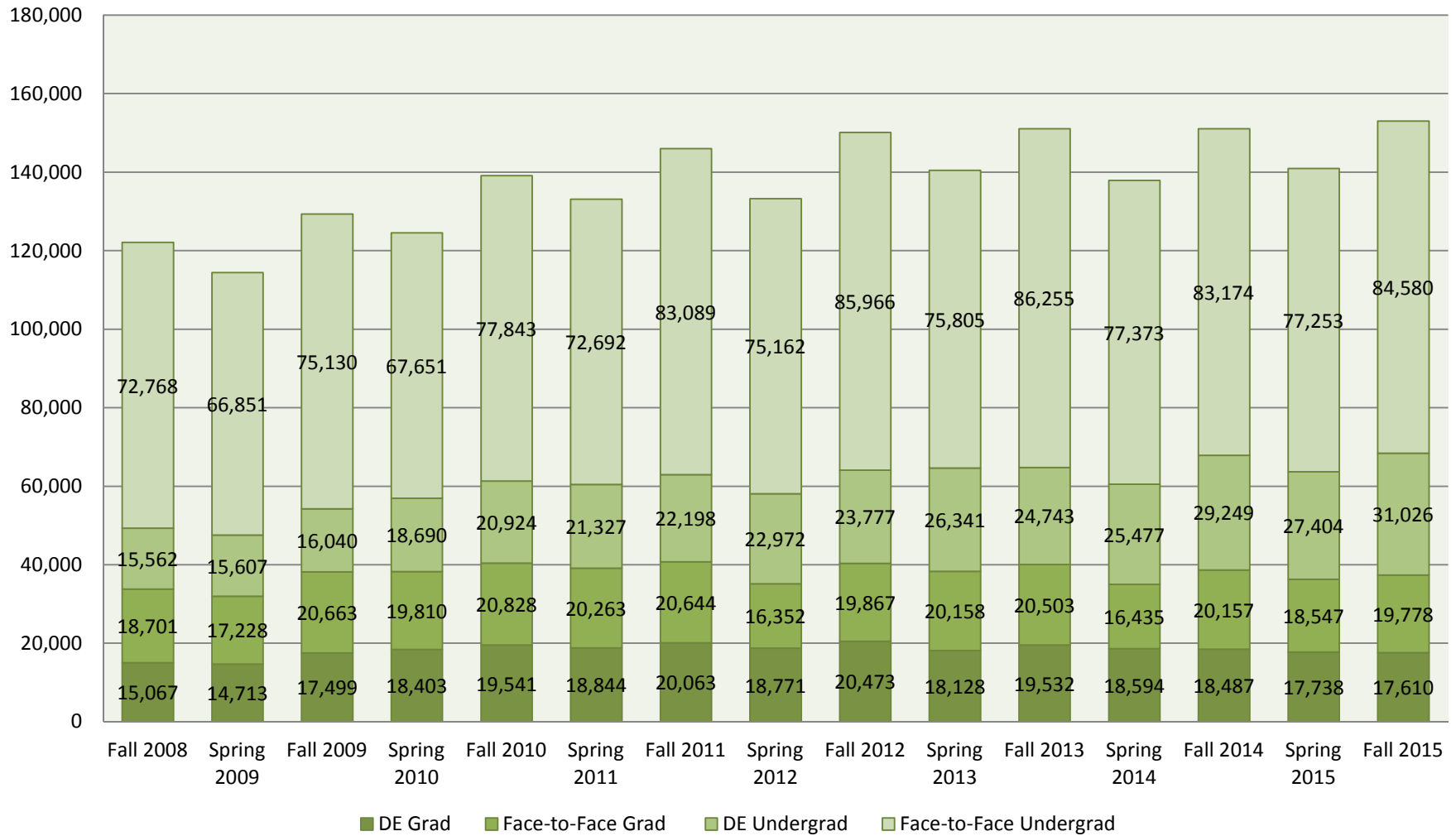

## Percentage of Distance Education FTE & SCH Generated by Graduate Students by Semester *Students Taking Only DE Courses*



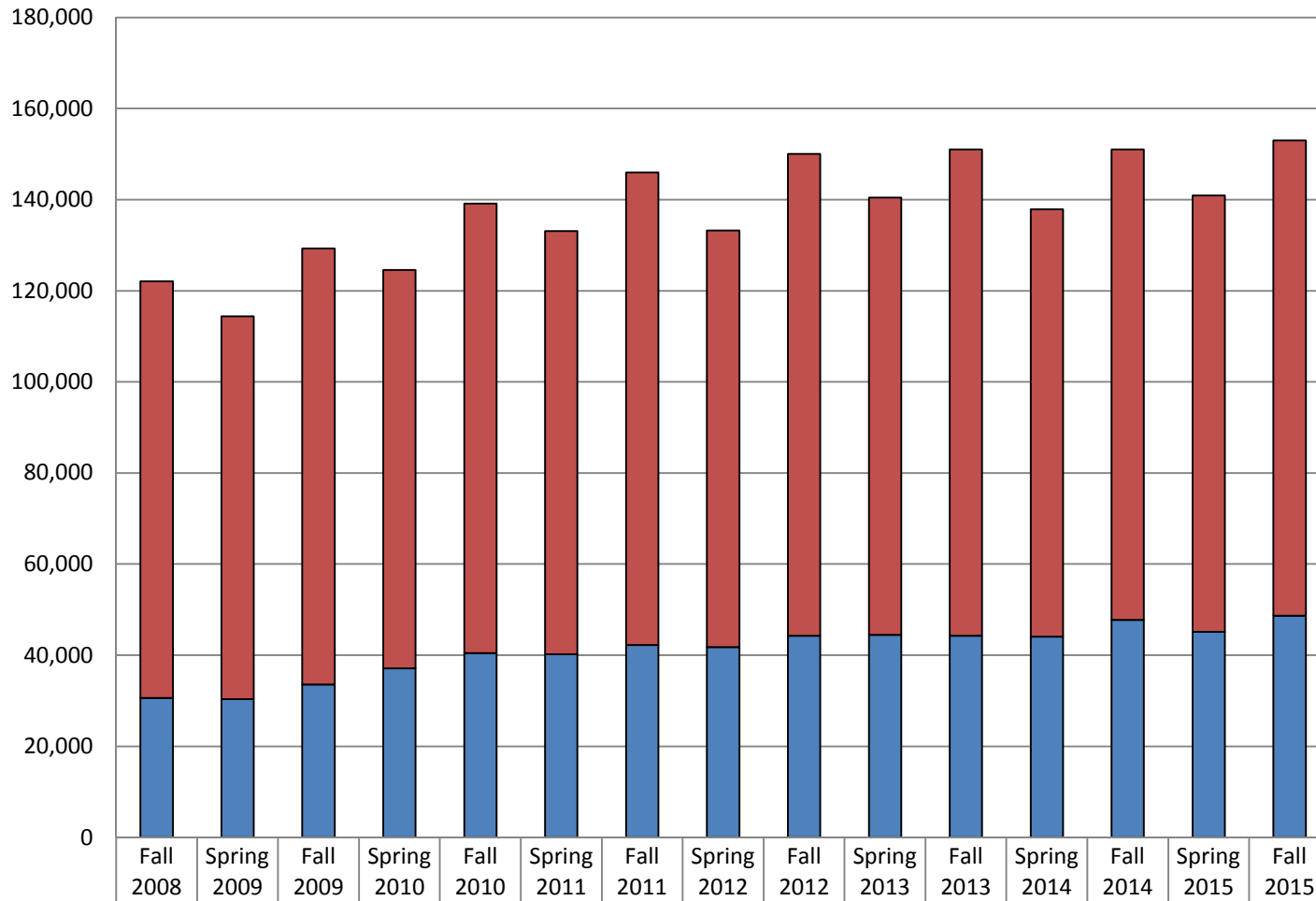

## TWU Semester Credit Hour Composition \* As of 9/10/2015





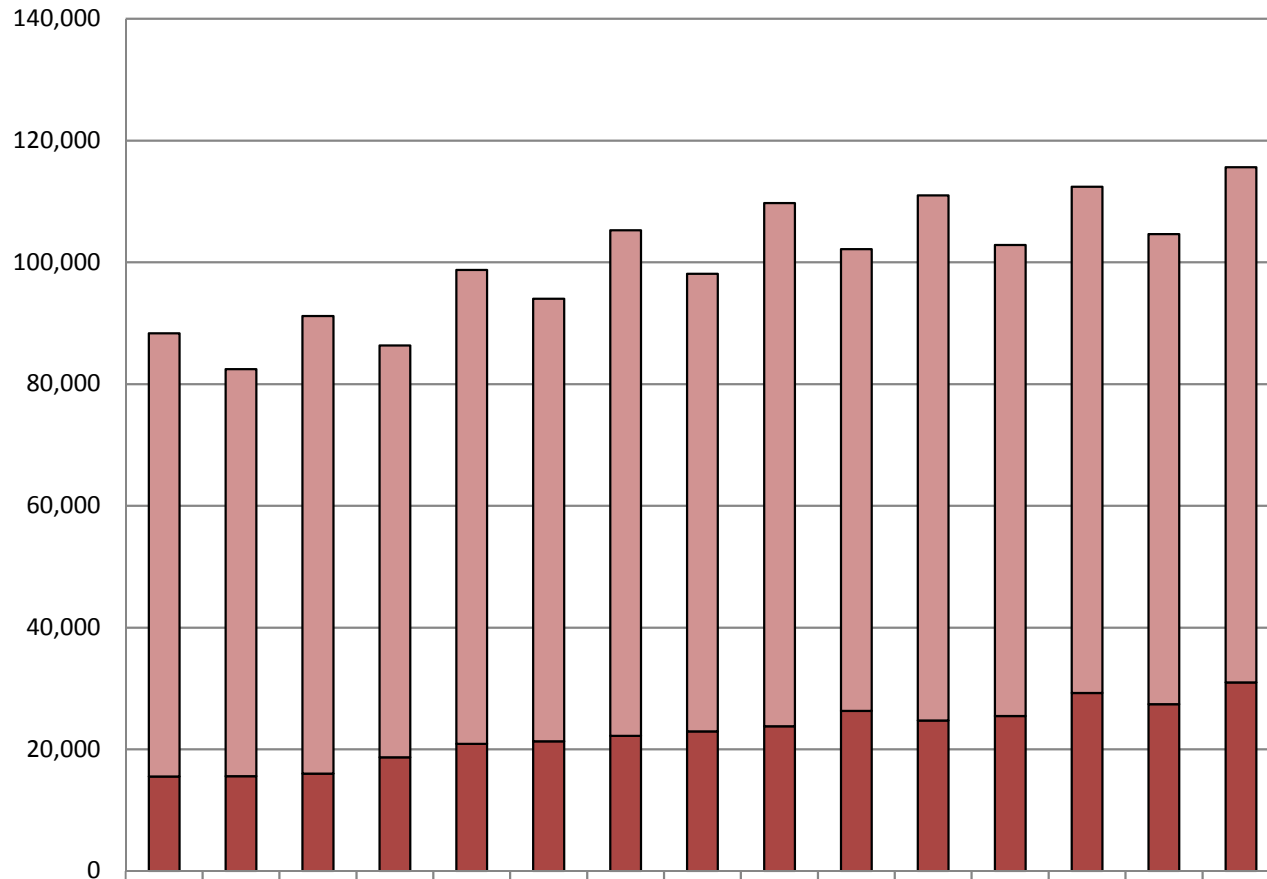

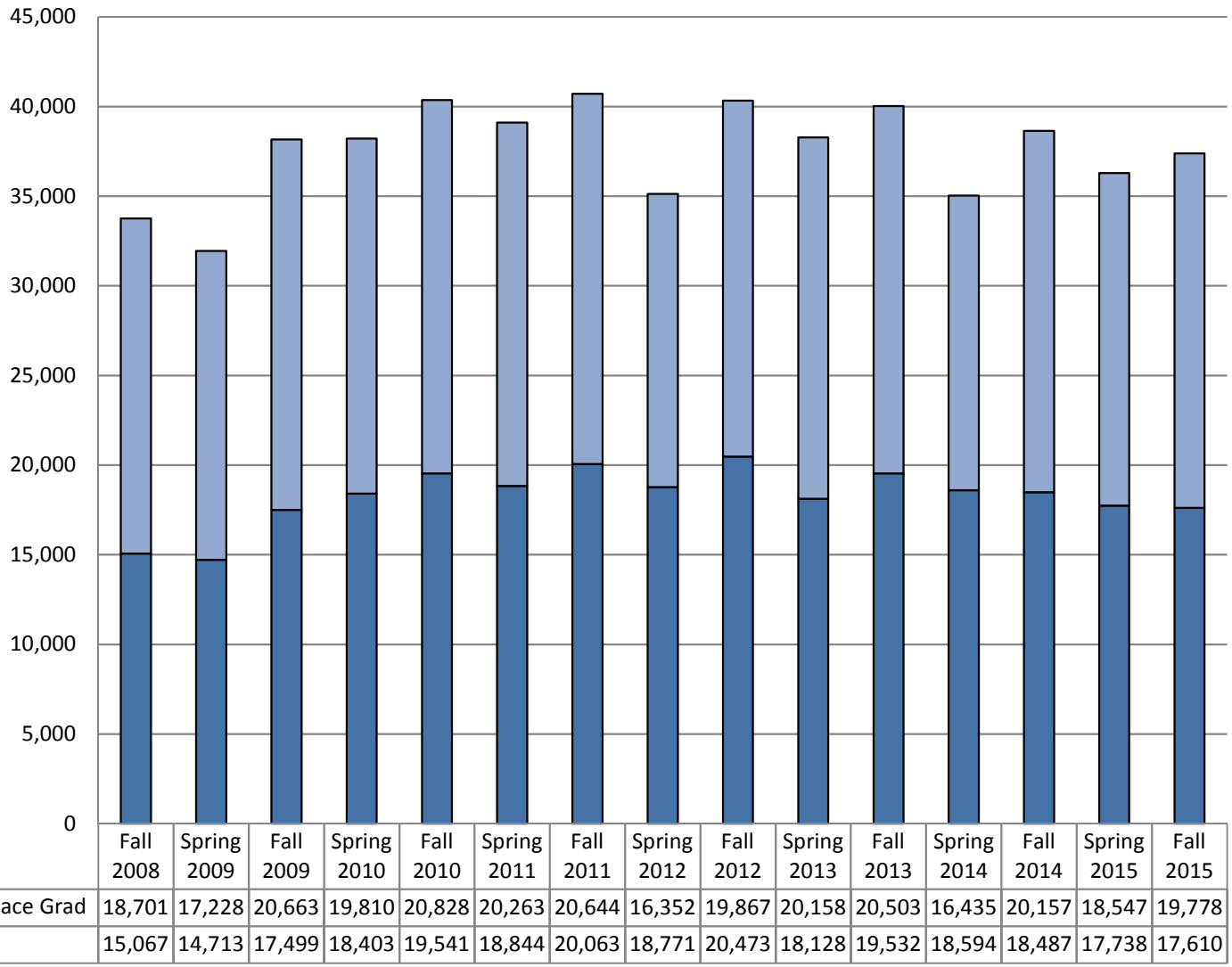
